Another season at the R-Ranch has come to a close. This season was filled with major challenges such as: the completion of the Cottonwood lodge taking longer than we hoped, the loss and replacement of the trap machine at the gun range, fires threatening the R-Ranch which caused heavy smoke, evacuation of the string horses, cancelation of some events and a budget crisis due to insurance rates that nearly tripled. The good news through all the challenges were amazing such as: the R-Ranch staff stepped up and provided owners with great service. This was a year we had fewer employees than in any year I can recall, yet they were able to keep the events running smoothly. The grounds of the R-Ranch are looking good. The dedication the employees have shown should be commended by all. The dinners and dances were well attended and the bands this year were amazing. The stables events were well attended & again, the stables staff did an amazing job working shorthanded.

Then we have owners who stepped up volunteering time and materials to help make improvements at both campgrounds. The trap machine was beyond repair and the board voted to replace it. Again, many owners stepped up and donated money to help cover the cost of the replacement. Together, owners and employees make the R-Ranch work.

The Cottonwood pool lodge is now completed and open and many have enjoyed what it brings to the R-Ranch. We will be having meetings to determine what we can do with the remaining funds to enhance what this beautiful place has to offer. We must look to the future for what will continue to attract new owners. This year's marketing efforts have been successful. The sale of shares from R-

Ranch to date are at 35 in comparison of last year's 15. What this says top me is that people are recognizing what a great value the R-Ranch is, even in this economy.

If we as owners continue to work together, I see even greater things to come. New ideas bring more happy people to the ranch.

GM Report

As the R-Ranch is heading into winter, we have a lot of work to do. The campgrounds, both Klamath and Cottonwood have stayed consistent with owners this season, especially this October. It looks like we had a great beginning to the deer season, and it sounds like the fishing season is going well also. We have started to winterize water lines, tanks, and the wells. Here in the next week or so, we will start working on getting the water ways cleared on the Klamath River and Cottonwood Creek. We will also be pulling the irrigation pumps for the winter. I have still been in contact with Cal Fire and Hornbrook Fire Department about coming in and burning the slash pile behind the stables and the cat tails on the pond above the pool. They are waiting to do this until after the first two rains come.

We are excited to have the pool lodge done, up and running. S & B James will be back a few more times to do some touch ups and miscellaneous things before we send them their last payment. Once the line shack use slows down, we will continue to work on them and get them all redone. We will also be turning the Cottonwood Welcome Center into a two-bedroom, one bath rental this winter. The River House and the A Frame have been constantly booked this summer and if you would like to make reservations for any of the rentals, I would say to try to do it as far in advance as possible due to them booking up so quickly.

We will be down to twelve employees by 10/17/22 and we will be starting up Owner Services again. Thank you to all the owners this year that have helped keep an eye out on the property so we could try to save as much money as possible.

As of 10/11/22 we have sold 35 new shares from HQ. This time last year there were 15 new shares sold. Thank you to all the owners for getting the word out!! Most of the tours I do, hear about the R-Ranch by word of mouth. Finally, I want to say thank you to all the owners that have volunteered their time and money this year to help make the R-Ranch look better. Thank you to all!!

Did you know the R-Ranch was once called The Bray Ranch? In 1912, 640 acres where headquarters and the stables are, was once owned by Walter Bray and his family. He and his wife Verna raised 9 children on the property. They all worked hard raising cattle, gardening, planting trees, milking cows, and harvesting hay and grain on the land. They also piped in the water from a spring to the house (Headquarters). Walter Bray and his wife sold the ranch in 1936 due to ill health. Mrs. Bray and one of her sons visited the ranch in 1972 and couldn't believe how beautiful it was. They were reminded of all the wonderful memories they had being fortunate enough to call it home at one time.
